Pursuant to Section 2.29 of the *Local Government Act 1995* and before the Chief Executive Officer, Councillor's Elect Cowell, Ridgley, Stubberfield and Smith will read aloud and sign their Declarations of Office of Councillor for the Shire of Shark Bay.

6.0 **ELECTION OF PRESIDENT**

Under Section 2.28 and Schedule 2.3 of the *Local Government Act 1995* the Chief Executive Officer will invite nominations in writing for the position of President for a period of two (2) years.

<u>Note:</u> if more than one nomination is received and confirmed an election for the position of President will be conducted by a secret ballot by the Chief Executive Officer.

The newly elected President will read aloud and sign the Declaration of Office of President before the authorised person.

The newly elected President will assume the Chair.

7.0 ELECTION OF DEPUTY PRESIDENT

Under Section 2.29 and Schedule 2.3 of the *Local Government Act 1995* the President will invite nominations in writing for the position of Deputy President for a period of two (2) years.

<u>Note:</u> if more than one nomination is received and confirmed an election for the position of Deputy President will be conducted by a secret ballot by the Chief Executive Officer.

The newly elected Deputy President will read aloud and sign the Declaration of Office of Deputy President before the authorised person.

8.0 ELECTION TO COMMITTEES

DEVELOPMENT ASSESSMENT PANELS - LOCAL GOVERNMENT NOMINATIONS

Following the upcoming local government elections to be held on 16 October 2021, there may be a change in your local government DAP membership if the composition of your council changes. All existing local government DAP members are currently appointed for a term ending 26 January 2022. Prior to this expiry date, your local government will need to nominate four (4) DAP members for appointment by the Minister for Planning.

Representation of local interests is a key aspect of the DAPs system. Under regulation 24 of the *Planning and Development (Development Assessment Panels) Regulations 2011* your local council is requested to nominate, as soon as possible following the elections, four elected council members to sit as DAP members for your local government. Using the attached form, nominations should be submitted via email to the DAPs Secretariat at daps@dplh.wa.gov.au.

All local government councils are requested to provide nominations for local government DAP members by Friday 19 November 2021, to ensure local interests are represented in future DAP determinations. If you are unable to provide nominations by the above date, please contact the DAPs Secretariat to discuss alternative arrangements and implications. Once nominations are received, the Minister will appoint local government DAP members for the term ending 26 January 2024.
